

Lending

4-week lending period applies to:

- Books
- Audiobooks, Tonies (audio figures) and Music CDs
- PC Games and Board Games
- Topical DVDs
- Children's magazines

2-week lending period applies to:

- Periodicals
- Console games
- Library of Things
- DVDs/Blu-rays

Extensions

Basically, you can extend media online in your user account (up to 3x per medium, magazines and Bestsellers 1x). For existing reservations, no extension is possible.

Overdue charges

After the lending period expires, the following fees are due per medium and opening date:

for children (until 14 years of age)	0.10 euro
for teenagers and adults	0.30 euro

Reminder fees

If media are not returned within the lending period, a reminder is issued and is additionally charged regardless of the default fees:

1st Reminder	1.00 euro
2nd Reminder	2.50 euros
3rd Reminder	4.00 euros
Fee reminder	1.00 euro

Everything under one roof: Our media diversity

The Ulm City Library offers around 600,000 media on all topics: books, magazines, newspapers, audio books, films, music, console and board games and much more. We are also happy to advise you at our locations.

Working, learning & meeting*

We offer group work spaces as well as quiet learning and work spaces as well as relaxed seating. Free Wi-Fi, internet workstations and printers/copiers are available for you.

Library of Things

In Böfingen, Wiblingen and the glass pyramid, we also lend everyday items, e.g. sledges, photo scanners, game consoles, musical instruments, outdoor games, instant cameras, action cams, kites, etc.

Interlibrary loan*

Can't find scientific literature? You can order them from other libraries for a fee.

Gaming*

We offer Nintendo Switch and PlayStation 5 for up to four players aged 6 and up, free of charge and without registration. The available games are regularly changed out.

Historical inventory

As one of the oldest city libraries in Germany, we have around 40,000 titles in our collection, which were published before 1830. With the "Adopt a Book" donation program of the Bibliotheksgesellschaft Ulm e.V. (Ulm Library Association (CIO)), we are working together to preserve valuable books.

Makerspace*

From idea to finishing the project: The Makerspace is the creative space in the Central Library. Here, your own projects can be implemented in the textile workshop, on the 3D printer, laser cutter, cutting machine and many more. An initial briefing for the respective device is required. Events

References with Munzinger, Duden and Brockhaus

Munzinger provides you with reliable information in the form of comprehensive online reference works, in particular for country information and biographies. In addition, the Duden Basic Knowledge School series is available online. The Brockhaus online encyclopaedia provides citation-capable information for children and adults.

Genios press portal

You can receive a **library card** by presenting your personal identification (alternatively a passport + your address registration certificate) and receive access to Ausleihe right away.

For children up to 14 years of age we require the consent of a parent (see the consent form on our website).

By signing the library card, you undertake to comply with the library rules.

Costs (per year)

- 30 euros: adults
- 15 euros: students, trainee lawyers, volunteers, employees, holders of the National Family Pass & Disabled
- Free of charge: children and young people up to 18 years old, students, trainees, Germany's citizen's benefit (Bürgergeld) recipients, Lobbycard holders
- 4 euros: Daily pass (to borrow from any number of media on the day of validity to the usual lending periods, no extensions allowed)

Additional rental fee

DVDs, Blu-rays and console games, each	1.00 euro
Lending period extension of these media, each	1.00 euro
Interlibrary loan, per order	3.00 euros
Reserving of borrowed media	1.00 euro

Individual settings in your reader account

- In your library account, you can set online whether and how many days in advance you want to receive a reminder (only with a saved email address).
- You can receive a pick-up reminder for a reservation as well as receipts for loans or returns (only with a saved email address).
- You have the option to independently extend your ID.
- By default, your date of birth is set as a password. For security reasons, we recommend creating an individual password.

Loss or damage

Please check media for completeness and integrity before borrowing and report any defects. For functional errors you detect during use, please inform us with the return. In the event of loss or damage to borrowed media, in principle, you must provide full compensation, i.e., purchase value + value of all associated parts + re-processing fee of 5 euros.
